

Painting / Staining Instructions for High-Definition Fiberglass Garage Doors

Use a gel type stain or any exterior stain formulated for fiberglass doors. Follow manufacturer's recommendations for surface preparation and stain application.

Painting unfinished doors

To paint unfinished doors, sand lightly with 600 grit sandpaper, then clean with denatured alcohol. A good quality acrylic latex house paint should adhere to the fiberglass. Check adhesion before painting the entire door. Follow the manufacturer's recommendations.

Repainting finished doors

To repaint factory finished doors, sand lightly with 600 grit sandpaper, then clean the surface with water and a mild detergent. Paint with a good quality acrylic latex house paint. Follow the manufacturer's recommendations.

Post-Warranty Finish Maintenance Instructions

To better maintain the beauty and durability of the woodtone finish of fiberglass pre-finished doors, we suggest a protective clear coat of satin or semi-gloss exterior polyurethane at three year intervals beginning at the expiration of the 3-year factory finish warranty. The manufacturer is not responsible for the finish after the 3-year finish warranty expires.
